4.2 Quality and importance

Apprezzabile vegetazione idrofita di acque fredde oligotrofiche; la vicina piccola torbiera ospita alcune specie paludicole di un certo interesse. Si tratta di un biotopo di vitale importanza per la riproduzione di molte specie di anfibi e rettili.
