Profonda forra calcarea della Val di Non, percorsa dal torrente Noce, delimitata da alte pareti rocciose, con stillicidi e vegetazione rupestre. Sono presenti habitat di particolare interesse non compresi nell'all.I della direttiva 92/43/CEE, in particolare: Orno - Ostryon (25%).

4.2 Quality and importance

L'importanza del sito è dovuta alla grandiosità della forra e alla sua flora e vegetazione rupicola. Il sito è inoltre di rilevante importanza per la nidificazione, la sosta e/o lo svernamento di specie di uccelli protette o in forte regresso, e/o a distribuzione localizzata sulle Alpi. Presenza di invertebrati dell'allegato II che indicano buona naturalità delle acque correnti.
